In re Universal Service Fund Telephone Billing Practices Litigation 232 F.R.D. 669 (D.Kan. 2005)

The court rejected separate e-mail strands that were treated as individual documents. A privilege log must "provide sufficient information for a court to determine whether or not each element of an asserted privilege or work product protection claim is satisfied". This ruling requires separate privilege logs for each e-mail thread that must always include: a description of each e-mail that is said to be privileged, the date it was written and sent, the person who wrote it and for whom it was written for, the reason for writing it, the specific privilege being asserted, and any additional information that is pertinent for the claim.

Due to this court ruling, separate privilege log treatments can be very time consuming and costly...
